## Safety Tips for Trick or Treating

-  Children should always be accompanied by a responsible adult.
-  It is advised kids go out in daylight hours.

-  Be careful when crossing the road. Stop and look both ways!
-  Be wary of dogs in properties.
-  It is advised that edible treats are examined by a parent or guardian before being consumed.
-  Kids should always wait for their treats outside and never enter a stranger's house or car.
